What Did Daddy (and Mommy) Do? Locating Family Members in Old Business Records – Part I

Our ancestors spent much of their lives at work, and many records reflect their occupations. Whether they were factory workers, farmers, miners, or business owners, a variety of sources—such as business records, licenses, censuses, directories, and newspaper advertisements—can provide insight into their professional lives. This presentation introduces the types of occupational records that exist and where to find them. You'll learn how to uncover these sources and use them to add depth and detail to your ancestors' stories. This is a great session for discovering general occupational records across a range of industries.
